Submission must be for 100 pieces of artwork 3. Each artwork must have a minimum of two colours 4. Sites for installation will be curated by the MBDA <p>The project intends to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Create work opportunities for local artists. b) Install colourful mosaic artwork in the inner-city c) Document the impact of COVID-19. <p>Requirements from Artist:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Artist will need to comply with all applicable COVID-19 regulations. 2. The Artist is expected to submit a proposal detailing the theme of the collection 3. The artist must submit images of previous artwork of a <i>similar</i> nature. 4. The artist must submit images / portfolio of previous artworks 5. Obtain a permit to work during lockdown. 6. Be registered on National Treasury Central supplier database (CSD) 7. Total costs must include material, labour, studio and all applicable costs in installing the artworks.
